

Tanzania Officers in IRTE

On the request of the Tanzanian Government, the IRTE conducted courses for police officers, traffic engineers and medical doctors from Tanzania.



The courses were titled as Road Safety Audit, Traffic Calming and Development of Road Safety Indices on the National Road Network; Training of the Trainers on Emergency Care to Local Community and Support Accident Victims and Scientific Systems of Road Crash Investigation, Reconstruction and Analysis.





Each course was of a 3 week duration and was held at the IRTE's College of Traffic Management. In order to design the courses, the IRTE initiated a comprehensive study on the legislations, codes and practices in Tanzania as well as the problems faced by the police, highway engineers and doctors in the above referred areas.
