<u>Highway Road Safety Literacy Programme for Villages</u>

Although the National & State Highways constitute only 6% of the total road length in India, 64% of almost 1,00,000 annual road collision fatalities in the country occur on these highways.



IRTE chalked out a pioneering proposal for imparting road safety education to villages situated along the highways. The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Govt. of India, extended its support to this endeavour of IRTE by sponsoring and supporting many road safety literacy programmes.









IRTE conducted area-specific programmes specially tailored to suit the requirement of a particular area or region. Under an NHAI programme the IRTE has imparted Road Safety Education on the entire 1463 kms. stretch of the National Highway-2, extending from Delhi to Kolkata.
